### Essential

1. A Christian who subscribes to the Street Pastors' core values, and understands and embraces the unique ethos of the Street Pastors' Movement
2. Ability to travel locally, and on occasions, nationally
3. Ability to work within a team, manage conflict and to work with a variety of people with different beliefs, values and backgrounds, and maintain confidentiality
4. Good communication skills, including the ability to establish rapport and deliver information to a diverse audience; good public speaking, presentation and training skills and an ability to write clear letters, newsletters and reports
5. Reasonable IT skills
6. Willingness to work unsocial hours (eg late evening patrols)
7. Knowledge of different church traditions
8. Ability to identify problems and create solutions
9. Completion of the Street Pastor Confidential Self-Declaration Form
10. DBS clearance

11. Ability to demonstrate knowledge, skills and experience of leadership, as well as the management of significant projects
12. Experience of working with a wide range of young people
